Security Theft - Protect Yourself

1) Double check credit card statements

Check your credit card statement regularly and ensure there are no unauthorized transactions. If you see any irregular transactions report them to your card company immediately.

2) Shred sensitive documents

Shred any and all sensitive documents that include any of your personal information.

3) Don't share information

If you can don't share your personal information but unfortunately this is not reality many institutions and organizations require this information. However whoever you share your information with ensure that they have processed to ensure your information is safe.

4) Use a "strong" passwords and more than one

Life is easier using your birth date as your password for everything. The rule of thumb is if it is easy for you it is easy for them. When creating passwords use capitals, numbers and special characters like ! @#\$%^&*().

5) Keep your credit cards to a minimum

In general you should only need 2 credit cards. The fewer credit cards you have, the better. Only keep the credit cards you actually use or plan on using and remember to verify the transactions frequently.

6) Secure your computer

Make sure you upgrade your computer OS regularly and have updated antivirus and firewall. Install an external firewall between the internet and you computer(s). This will help prevent hackers from gaining illicit access to your computer.

7) Protect your mail

Don't leave your mail in your mailbox for extended periods of time unprotected. Invoices, bills and other information can be used to create new accounts with your information.

8) No one needs your Social Security Number except your employer.

This is the simple one DO NOT GIVE OUT YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. If companies ask for your social security number do not give it out. There is no reason they should need it.
